List spelling words in ABC order.	Make a word math problem. Example: give - e + ing = giving	Make flash cards. Practice words with a family member.	Find spelling words in a dictionary. Write their meaning.	Write your spelling words. See how many small words you can find and write them down. Example: s t o r y toy, so, try, rosy, rots, sort, toys
Shortest to Longest	Sentences	Riddles	Rebus	Antonyms/ Synonyms
Count the number of letters in each word. Then write the words in order from shortest to longest.	Write a sentence for each spelling word, using the word in the sentence.	Make riddles, with spelling words as the answers.	Make a rebus story using pictures instead of spelling words. Include a key.	Make three columns: titled Spelling Word, Antonym, and Synonym. Then write an antonym and synonym for each word. Or write a phrase that would have the opposite or same meaning as each word.

Divide words into syllables. Example: stor - y	Search for your spelling words in newspapers or magazines. Glue the words to a piece of construction paper.	Write each letter in your spelling words with a different color.	Write a story using spelling words. Use as many spelling words as you can. Underline the spelling words.	Make a mini-dictionary with word, picture, and sentence.
Word Shapes	2-Color Words	Telephone Words	Arrow Words	Silly Sentences
Write each word. Then draw boxes around the letters to show the shapes of the words. Example: 	Write each spelling word, using one color for vowels and one color for consonants.	Write each spelling word. Then translate each word into numbers from a telephone keypad. Example: SPELL 77355	Start with the first letter of the word, then add a letter each time. After you have all the letters in the word, take a letter away each time. Example: WORD w wo wor word wor wo w	Underline each letter of your spelling word. The first letter in the word in the sentence and so on. Example: BROOK Bobby ran over old kites.
