Impetigo Alert

Your child may have been exposed to Impetigo.



What to look for:

- ✓ Tiny red bumps that look like insect bites or scrapes.
- ✓ Bumps quickly become pus-filled blisters.
- ✓ Clumps of blisters break, and form golden crusty sores.
- ✓ Sores may itch slightly.
- ✓ Check for bumps in the mouth and nose.
- ✓ Symptoms develop 1-3 days after exposure.
