

Strep Throat Alert

Your child has been exposed to Strep Throat. The approximate date of exposure is posted on the website.

What to look for:

- ✓ Sudden fever (99.⁰ to 104.⁰ F.), severe sore throat, pain when swallowing, chills.
- ✓ White pus pockets in back of the throat.
- ✓ Swollen glands in the neck.
- ✓ Nausea, vomiting, &/or abdominal pain.
- ✓ Headache.
- ✓ Symptoms can develop 1-5 days after exposure.
- ✓ **Untreated Strep Throat can lead to *rheumatic fever, heart or kidney disease.***
