

Shawnee Mission School District Developmental Screening For Children ages 2.9 – 5 Years



WHAT: A Developmental Screening that assesses vision, hearing, personal-social development, gross and fine motor skills, and speech and language skills.

WHO: Children ages 2 years, 9 months through 5 whose parent(s), physician or preschool teachers have expressed concerns in the areas of learning, speech, language, fine motor or gross motor skills, behavior, vision or hearing. This is not designed to screen school-aged children or children for kindergarten readiness.

WHY: The purpose of these screenings is to identify children who are at risk of having substantial developmental delays if early intervention services are not provided.

CALL: Call the school nurse at your neighborhood school to schedule the screening appointment.

WHEN: Call for your screening appointment at any time during the school year. Screenings are held on a monthly basis from September through April.

FOLLOWING SCREENING: The Screening Team will interpret the results of the screening and their recommendations immediately.

INFANT TODDLER SCREENING
