- **“Let’s Get Growing”** is an interactive pre-teen health education program. In this one day class, **parents and children age 9-12** learn together about puberty, hygiene, reproduction and social development.
- We utilize a **“family centered”** approach that is team-taught. The instructors present factual information and facilitate discussion, and parents and children share their views with one another.
- **“Let’s Get Growing”** helps encourage communication within the family about sexuality in a relaxed, fun atmosphere. Boys and Girls are taught in separate rooms.
